**SERMON: *Walking in the Light!***

**TEXT: John 8:1-12; 1 John 1:5-7**

**Intro: In John 8, Jesus defends a woman caught in adultery by reminding her accusers that they, too, are sinners. He does not condone her sin, but says that He is the eternal light of the world and existed before Abraham was born. What do we learn from John 8:1-12?**
