B. He is the peace in the storm (Mark 4:35-40). See Psalm 46:10.

II. Heaven is real (v. 2).

A. Many mansions (v. 2).

B. “The city is pure gold” (Revelation 21:18).

C. “The street of the city is pure gold” (Revelation 21:21).

D. “No night there” (Revelation 21:25; 22:5).

E. “The tree of life” (Revelation 22:2, 14).

F. “No bad people” (Revelation 21:27).

G. “No death, sorrow or pain” (Revelation 21:4).

III. Jesus is coming again to take us to heaven to be with Him for eternity (v. 3).

A. The angels announced at his ascension that He is coming again (Acts 1:11).

B. He will take us to His Father (I Corinthians 15:24).

C. He will come from glory to take us to glory (Colossians 3:4).
