I. WE ARE PRAYING TO AN EVER-PRESENT, LIVING GOD.

- A. Every prayer in the Bible is offered to a personal God.
- B. Heb. 11:6; Heb. 13:5; Matt. 28:20; Psalm 139:1-17
- C. Sing: "Our God, He Is Alive." (1, 2 chorus 3, 4 chorus)

II. WE NEED HIM.

- A. Prayer assumes the weakness of man and the unlimited strength of God.
- B. John 15:5
- C. Sing: "Abide With Me" (All 5)

III. GOD HEARS PRAYER.

- A. As we pray we move up to God and he moves down to us.
- B. James 4:8; 1 Pet. 3:12; 1 Pet. 5:6, 7; 1 John 5:14
- C. Sing: "Tis The Blessed Hour Of Prayer" (All 4)

IV. GOD ANSWERS PRAYER.

- A. He is here! He listens! He has power! He will answer!
- B. John 15:7, 16; John 16:23; 1 John 5:15
- C. Notice that God answers only those who believe in Christ.

1 John 5:13; James 2:17

D. Luke 13:3; Rom. 10:10; Acts 22:16

- 2. With a determined, diligent prayer life we can succeed.
