- B. Mary and Joseph were poor.
- C. Simeon -- Anna -- Mary and Joseph.

CONC:

- 1. Remember holding your infant child?
- 2. When all was determined to be ok remember the feeling of peace?
 - a. Simeon. "Die in peace"
 - b. Have you held the Christ child, looked into his face, and found peace?
- 3. Did you tell anyone about it when your child was born?
 - a. Anna. "Spoke of him to all" -- herald
 - b. Have you held the baby and then shared the good news?
- 4. Isn't birth marvelous?
 - a. Mary and Joseph. "They marveled at those things spoken."
 - b. Have you held the baby God and marveled at what he would mean to mankind?
- Let me put the baby in your arms. Look into the eyes of the Christ-child.
- 6. What do you feel? Peace? A desire to tell the world? Guilt?
- As you observe the small hands, tiny feet, precious face remember -- in just thirty-three short years they would be pierced and torn for you.
