## IT SAYS SOMEWHERE IN THE BIBLE...OR DOES IT? Acts 17:11

#### INTRO:

- 1. One of the critical issues in our relationship with God is that of authority.
- 2. The people of Jesus' day once asked him, Matt. 21:23
- 3. The question was and is an important one.

## I. I MUST ACCEPT THE BIBLE AS THE STANDARD OF AUTHORITY.

- A. It is the word of God. 2 Pet. 1:21
- B. It will equip me for every good work. 2 Tim. 3:16, 17
- C. I will be judged by it. Rev. 20:12; John 12:48

#### II. I MUST BE CAREFUL TO DOCUMENT ITS TEACHING.

- A. Many agree the Bible is God's revelation, but do not take the time and effort to know what is in it.
- B. Have you ever heard these "chimney corner" scriptures? They are usually preceded by "You know the good book says..."
  - 1. The time will come when there will be seven women cleaving to one man's coat tail.
  - 2. Feed your enemy with a long handled spoon.
  - 3. I'm going to do like Solomon and let it ride.
  - Every stitch you sew on Sunday, you will have to rip out on Monday. (You rip what you sew.)
  - 5. A whistling woman and a crowing hen are of no account to God or men.
  - You can dance all day long, and you don't sin if you don't cross your legs.
  - 7. If you get drunk, don't waller.
- C. I can't find book, chapter, and verse for these passages, but try the following.
  - I. If someone hurts you, tell as many people as quickly as possible to get others on your side.
  - 2. If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone.
  - 3. Seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness.
  - 4. Try to work in a little religion as you have time, but don't be a fanatic.
