Important Verses In Sharing The Gospel Mark 16: 15, 16

INTRO:

- God intends for us to share his word with others.
- 2. This morning I want to share some key verses for us to remember as we contemplate our opportunities to teach others.

I. Isaiah 55:10, 11

- A. God's word is unique.
- B. He created by his word. Gen. 1:3; Heb. 11:3
- C. Jesus is called the Word. John 1:1-4, 14; Luke 5:20; John 11:43; Matt. 8:26; Matt. 8:32; Matt. 8:3, 13
- D. God's words are powerful and His word (the Bible) is described as having many qualities. 2 Tim. 3:16; John 17:17; John 8:32;
 Rom. 10:17; Heb. 4:12

II. Romans 1:16

- A. What is the gospel? I Cor. 15:1-4
- B. The gospel of God is his work in Christ.

III. John 12:32

- A. Jesus is speaking about his crucifixion. He draws to himself all who are to be saved.
- B. When I present the gospel, Jesus draws the sinner to himself. He does the work, not me.
- C. As Christians, we are to share the gospel with truth, honesty and integrity.
- **D.** As God provides opportunities, I should respond in a humble and gentle spirit. **2 Tim. 2:24-26**
- E. When I understand the power of God's word and the gospel and the drawing power of Jesus, then I know the responsibility of salvation rests on God, not me. Rom. 10:14
