RESPONSIBILITIES OF MEMBERS TO ELDERS

INTRO:

- 1. We proceed with the following understanding.
 - a. Christ is the head of the church. Eph. 1:22, 23; 2 John 9; John 12:48
 - b. Elders have God given authority. Acts 20:28; 1 Tim. 3:5; Heb. 13:7, 17
 - c. Elders exercise this authority in matters of judgment.
 - d. Our elders are scripturally qualified.
 - e. The responsibilities of elders and members complement each other.
- 2. We will consider various passages.

I. 1 THESS. 5:12, 13.

A. Know.

- 1. Elders know the members because shepherds know sheep. **John 10:2, 3**
- 2. Members make the effort to know the elders.
- B. Esteem very highly. Eph. 3:20
- C. Be at peace. Tit. 1:9-11; Rom. 12:18; Eph. 4:1-3

II. 1 TIM. 5:17-20.

- A. Double honor. v. 17, 18
- B. Accusations against elders.
 - 1. Don't believe unfounded rumors and gossip. v. 19
 - 2. Those guilty of sin, rebuke publicly. v. 20
 - 3. This is to be done with any member. Matt. 18:15-17

III. HEB. 13:7, 17.

- A. Remember -- "To be mindful of, to call to mind."
- B. Whose faith follow --- "imitate, emulate."
- C. Obey -- "The obedience suggested is not by submission to authority but resulting from persuasion. An actual and outward result of the inward persuasion." **James 3:3**
- D. Submit -- "To give way, to yield."
- E. We are to be in subjection to our elders.
- F. To fail to do this is a violation of scripture and therefore is sin.

CONC:

- 1. We should pray for our elders as they lead.
- 2. We must assume our full responsibility in doing our part in relating to them as God has instructed.
