HOW MUCH IS ON MY ACCOUNT? Psalm 32:1, 2

INTRO:

- 1. How does the Lord forgive sins? 1 John 1:9
- 2. How does the Lord forget sins? Jer. 31:34
- 3. How can I forgive and forget? Matt. 6:14, 15

I. THE DEBT IS PAID.

- A. Illus: "...Jesus paid it all, all to him I owe..."
- B. God forgives sins through the blood of Christ.

II. GOD DID NOT FORGET THE FACTS OF SIN.

- A. God did not forget the facts of the sins.
- B. He no longer charges those sins against their accounts.

III. DO I STILL HAVE A RECORD BOOK IN MY MEMORY?

- A. Do we still have a record book of the facts of hurts others inflicted upon us or sins they committed?
- B. When we forgive, do we mark paid on that page?
- C Be sure not to send another bill after the account has been settled.

IV. WHY NOT START THE NEW YEAR WITH ALL ACCOUNTS MARKED "PAID?"

- A. This is a perfect time to clear away the old debts.
- B. You may even have some that you think have not been paid because the person has yet to ask for forgiveness.
- C. Jesus died to pay the debt for all sin. Luke 23:34
- D. Even businesses, from time to time, write off the uncollected debts.

CONC:

- 1. As I learn to mark the debts "paid" I will be happier, and the church will be stronger.
- 2. Do I have to forget the facts of the sin? No.
- 3. My job is to not send any more bills.
- 4. That is forgiveness.
- 5. God offers forgiveness to each person here.
- 6. The plan of salvation is made possible by the death and resurrection of Christ.
