MARKS TO IDENTIFY THE NEW TESTAMENT CHURCH Matt. 16:13-18

INTRO:

- 1. There is only one body. Eph. 4:4; 1:22, 23
- 2. Today we will note aspects of the church in the New Testament which are important, but often overlooked.

I. FAITH – THE CONVICTION THAT CHRIST WAS WITH THEM.

- A. Christ assured them of this. Matt. 28:20; 18:20
- B. They believed that they were kept by the power of God. 1 Pet. 1:3-5

II. JOY AND ENTHUSIASM. Acts 2:46

- A. They were not complainers, but boosters. Phil 2:14, 15
- B. They were thrilled with an inward glow. Rom. 14:17
- C. They were fervent in spirit. Rom. 12:11

III. A SPIRIT OF "DO OR DIE;" WILLINGNESS TO TRY NEW THINGS. Tit. 3:1, 8, 14; 1 John 4:18

IV. A GENEROUS AND SACRIFICIAL SPIRIT.

- A. They were partners with God to win the world to goodness. 1 Cor. 3:9; Acts 2:42-47
- B. Early saints were so overwhelmed with God's favor that they sold everything voluntarily and shared it with others.

V. A SPIRIT OF UNITY, COMRADESHIP, AND BROTHERLY LOVE. John 13:35; Rom. 12:15

VI. THE SPIRIT OF EVANGELISM.

- A. All were involved. Gal. 3:26-28; Acts 8:4
- B. All were soul-conscious.
