- C. His reputation was ruined and he was a prisoner. (No way out)
- D. Despite all, he trusted God and did what was right.

II. JOB – THE RICHEST OF ALL AND A GOOD MAN. Job 1, 2

- A. Why me Lord?
- B. He put his faith in God and continued to do what was right.
