EQUIPPING TO SERVE Prov. 22:20, 21

INTRO:

- 1. In a general sense it can be said that the Bible was written to convict sinners of sin and to equip believers for service.
- 2. As we look at the Life of Christ this year, we should find truths and principles that will equip us to better follow in his steps.

I. GOD'S WORD EQUIPS FOR EVANGELISM.

- A. Philip used Isa. 53 to point the Ethiopian to Christ. Acts8:26-39
- B. It is the power of God for salvation. Rom. 1:16

II. GOD'S WORD EQUIPS FOR COUNSELING OTHERS.

- A. In his two letters to Timothy, Paul constantly urges him to preach the word of God.
 - 1 Tim. 1:3; 4:13-15; 2 Tim. 2:1, 2, 15; 1 Tim. 4:6
- B. This is Paul's counsel to a younger preacher.

III. GOD'S WORD EQUIPS FOR USING ONE'S GIFTS FROM GOD.

- A. A gift is an ability given by God to the believer for the purpose of edifying the church and glorifying God.
- B. Paul states that a knowledge of God's word will provide the maturity we need to use our gifts in the most effective way. **Eph. 1:17-19; 4:7, 11-14**

IV. GOD'S WORD EQUIPS US FOR DOING BATTLE WITH SATAN.

- A. The Christian is engaged in spiritual warfare.2 Cor. 10:3-6
- B. Our weapon is the word of God. Eph. 6:10-17

CONC:

- 1. We must rely on the word of God to make us strong.
- 2. It is only in his word that we find his will.
- 3. It is only through his word that we understand how to enjoy the relationship with him that can produce the success we desire as individuals and as a group.
