# Morning Lesson

## THE VICTORY Matt. 4:5-11

#### **INTRO:**

- 1. Satan quotes scripture and supposes he has me Jesus on his own ground.
- 2. He is demanding evidence of Jesus' faith.
- 3. "If you are the Son of God" is still there.

#### I. FAITH IS NOT PRESUMPTION.

- A. Satan thought he could take advantage of Jesus' humanity and get him to act boldly to make his point and let God pick up the pieces.
- B. "You shall not tempt the Lord your God." Deut. 6:16, Ex. 17:1-7: Heb. 11:6
- C. Faith is in no sense allied to presumption. Mark 14:38

#### II. DON'T LOSE COURAGE WHEN TEMPTED.

- A. Do not doubt God's leading.
- B. Jesus did not presume and go unbidden into the land of temptation, nor did he give up to despondency when the temptation came. 1 Cor. 10:13; Psalm 50:14, 15

# III. SATAN CLAIMS THE WORLD.

- A. Jesus could avoid the sorrow and hardship ahead by acknowledging the supremacy of Satan.
- B. He offered what he did not completely own. Dan. 4:17
- C. Jesus came to establish a kingdom of righteousness and he would not be bought.
- D. Satan makes the same offer to men today.

## CONC:

- 1. The way of the Lord in dealing with Satan is submission to and faith in God. James 4:7, 8
- 2. Satan's flees before those who find refuge in the name of God. **Prov. 18:10**
- 3. We will never fully appreciate the cost of our redemption until we stand with the redeemer and see what he gave up at the risk of eternal loss.
- 4. But through faith we can cast our crowns at his feet and sing. **Rev. 5:12**
