#### WHERE IS YOUR HEART? Matthew 6:16–24

#### INTRO:

- 1. Question: where is your heart? Who has it? What has it?
- 2. Jesus addresses four aspects of life and behavior and our hearts.

#### I. FASTING AND MY HEART. Matt. 6:16-18

- A. The OT did not have a specific command to fast. Lev.16:29, 31; Psalm 35:13
- B. Over time, periods of fasting were established to commemorate national disasters. **Zech. 8:19**; **Luke18:12**

#### II. YOUR TREASURE AND YOUR HEART. Matt. 6:1921

- A. What does it mean that "where your treasure is, there your heart will be also"? 1 Tim. 6:18, 19
- B. Banks like we have today were nonexistent. **James5:2, 3**
- C. Do not misunderstand what Jesus is saying.

## III. YOUR EYES AND YOUR HEART. Matt. 6:22, 23

- A. Jesus tells us to be full of light. **Prov. 22:9**; **Prov. 28:22**
- B. The same is true of the heart.

## IV. YOUR MASTER AND YOUR HEART. Matt. 6:24

- A. Have you ever tried to serve two masters?
- B. Is especially true when one of those masters is God.

### V. PUTTING ALL SECTIONS INTO CONTEXT

A. Your heart must be right when you engage in worshipful activities such as giving, praying, and fasting.

#### CONC:

- 1. Doctors tell us to take care of our hearts.
- 2. The Great Physician cares about your heart.
