### I. WHO WAS HE?

- A. The centurion was part of a well-trained and often ruthless army.
- B. It was unusual that he had so much concern for a servant.
- C. The centurion was also unusual in that he loved the Jews and built a synagogue for them.

# II. WHAT MADE HIS FAITH GREAT?

- A. He believed that Jesus could solve problems he could not solve. Luke 7:3; Eph. 3:20; 1 Pet. 5:7; Phil. 4:6-8
- B. Another reason his faith was great was his feeling of personal unworthiness before the Lord. Luke 7:6; Luke 7:4; Luke 5:8; Prov. 16:18
- C. The third reason was his grasp of Jesus' authority.
