I. REMEMBER THE LONELINESS OF JESUS.

- A. Often people did not understand him.
- B. He was rejected by his own hometown. John 1:11
- C. He was lonely that night in the garden.
- D. He hung on the cross alone...he understands loneliness.

II. LOCATE THE CAUSE OF LONELINESS.

- A. Loneliness can be caused by the Elijah complex. **Matt.7:1-4**
- B. We can be lonely because we are waiting for others to rush to our side instead of rushing to theirs.

 Luke 10:25-37
- C. Sometimes we can be lonely because we do not forgive others. **Rom. 3:23**
- D. We can be lonely because we build a wall that says "I don't need anyone, even God."

III. ACCEPT GOD'S ANSWERS TO LONELINESS.

- A. Search out someone that needs a friend and be one. **Prov.18:24**
- B. Forget the past: failures in relationships, sins of others, hurts. **Phil. 3:13, 14**
- C. Fill our lives with the abiding presence of God. Heb. 13:5

CONC:

- 1. If we are without God, there is always an emptiness in our hearts and lives.
- 2. God has the answer for loneliness.
- 3. The full cure will come when we arrive in heaven.
