- E. When we pass from this life, he is there. Psalm 23:4

# II. HE CAME AT A TIME OF DESPERATION.

- A. The woman had already known a great loss. Luke7:12
- B. As the dead son is a picture of the lost person and their dead condition; the poor widow is the picture of that lost individual who is helplessly trapped in the bondage of sin. **Eph. 2:1-3**; **Luke 4:18**

## III. HE CAME AT A TIME OF DELIVERANCE.

- A. The story does not end with a dead son and a desperate mother.
- B. Jesus had compassion on this woman.
- C. This is a picture of what Jesus does for those trapped in the cold grip of sin. Jer. 31:3
- D. He comes to us in grace. Eph. 2:8, 9
