Unity

The Scriptures taught me that...

- i. The unity of the Spirit will develop connections among believers (Ephesians 4:3)
- ii. The unity of faith encourages growth and maturity (Ephesians 4:13).
- iii. The unity of mind produces action (1 Peter 3:8)

Prayer

The Scriptures taught me that prayer...

- i. Is peaceful (Philippians 4:6).
- ii. Is protective (Philippians 4:7).
- iii. Is powerful (James 5:15-20).
- iv. Is a privilege (Isaiah 59:1-2).

Gospel

The Scriptures taught me that the Gospel is...

- i. A message that is above messenger (Romans 1:16-17).
- ii. A Scripture focused, Christ centered, salvation offering message (1 Corinthians 15:1-5).
- iii. An inspiring message that requires obedience (2 Thess. 1:8; John 3:16, 36).

I witnessed the Gospel transcend language barriers in its simplicity and inspire obedience on an Acts 2 scale.

Faith

The Scriptures taught me that faith...

- i. Is a rooted response to the Gospel message (James 1-2).
- ii. Will cultivate and appreciate the privilege of prayer (1 Thess. 5:17).
- iii. Brings us together as God intended in service to him (Heb. 10:19-25).
